4. Forests are hotspots of biodiversity containing different species of plants, animals and other organisms. Biodiversity of these life forms are conserved in forests which helps in maintaining ecological stability.

#### 5. Causes of deforestation:

- (i) Industries: Various industries like timber, paper, sports equipment obtain their raw materials from forest.
- (ii) Construction of road and dams.
- (iii) Clearing of forest for agriculture purpose.
