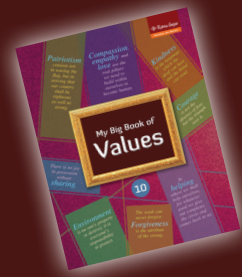

B. List the traits that Sumit exhibits that show that he does not have citizenship qualities.

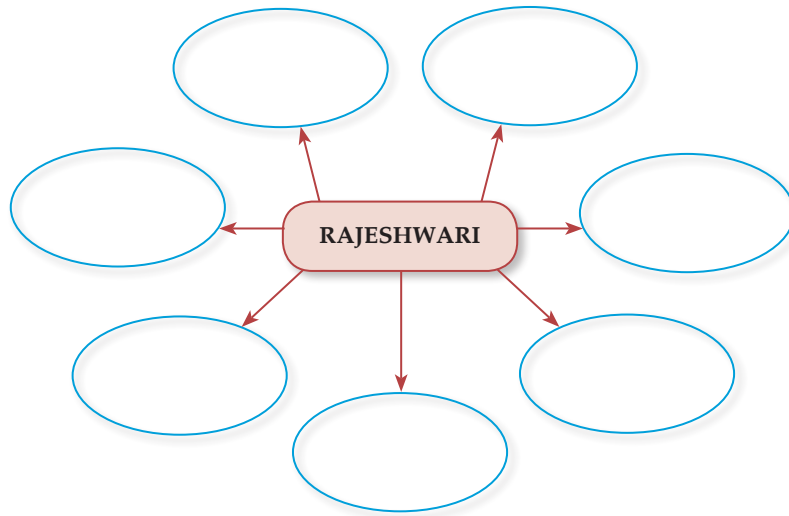
