

E. Study the given figure and answer the following questions.

1. Human Immunodeficiency Virus (HIV)

Parts

- i. Genetic material (RNA)
- ii. Protein coats
- iii. Lipid membrane
- 2. Acquired immunodeficiency syndrome (AIDS)
- HIV virus damages the antibody production mechanism of the body weakening the immune system of the infected person. Weakened immune system leads to several secondary infection which cause death of the individual.
- 4. Transmission of this disease takes place by sexual contact with infected person; transfusion of infected blood and during pregnancy from infected mother's blood to baby.
- 5. This disease can be prevented by
 - a. using barrier method of contraception during sexual intercourse.
 - b. screening of blood during transfusion.
 - c. avoiding pregnancy, if mother is HIV positive.
